Pembrokeshire Children and Young People's Rights Office

What is the Children & Young People's Rights Office?

The Children & Young People's Rights Office works to bring about positive change for children and young people living in Pembrokeshire. We work with lots of different youth forums in Pembrokeshire to enable children and young people to have a voice in decisions made about their lives.

Pembrokeshire Youth Assembly is facilitated by the Children & Young People's Rights Office and aims to be the voice of young people in Pembrokeshire by creating opportunities to participate in decision making on issues that impact upon the lives of Pembrokeshire's young people.

Children and young people have a right to be heard and their views and opinions should be listened to when making decisions about services for them and other things that affect their lives.

How many people are involved with Pembrokeshire Youth Assembly?

The youth assembly consists of approximately 35 enthusiastic young people from Pembrokeshire who are aged 14-25.

How can I become part of the Youth Assembly?

Members are elected onto the Pembrokeshire Youth Assembly from Pembrokeshire's secondary school councils and youth forums/councils:

- Area forums/youth councils are in: Milford Haven, Pembroke Dock, Fishguard, Haverfordwest, Tenby and Neyland
- Young Voices for Choices Youth Forum for young people with disabilities
- Junior Safeguardians (Pembrokeshire's junior local safeguarding children board)
- Young carers forum

Hi, I'm Jesse and I'm 11 years old - I'm also a young carer who looks after my mother

Jesse Ormond is a typical 11 year old boy who likes having fun like playing football with his friends or watching his favourite films on TV. He is also a young carer who, along with his 8 year old sister Layla, looks after his visually impaired mother. To mark Young Carers Awareness Day (26th January) Jesse has been talking about his experience of being a young carer and how Action for Children helps him and Layla.

Jesse and Layla from Pembroke Dock have been young carers for four years since their mother developed her condition and have been supported by Action for Children's Pembrokeshire Young Carers service for a year.

Jesse said: 'Since our mum became visually impaired, my sister, Layla and I look after her as much as we can every day. We sort out the washing, load and unload the dishwasher and make our own breakfasts in the morning before school. I also guide mum around town, helping her with her shopping and make sure she gets to her hospital appointments in Haverfordwest safely. This can take a lot of time and sometimes I get home just before bedtime but I'm ok with it.'

The young carers group is really good because I get to go to Oakwood! I get a bit more time to play so it's a big break for me. So if anyone else is in my position, it's really important to see if there's any help available like we get from Pembrokeshire Young Carers.'

Do you enjoy writing? Care Leaver? Coram Voice is launching its creative writing competition for care-experienced young people!

The children's rights charity Coram Voice has announced the return of 'Voices', the writing competition for care-experienced young people, for a second year. The competition launched on 9 January 2017 with the theme 'New Beginnings'. Coram Voice is asking children and young people to draw inspiration from a change in their lives or opportunities they've experienced to try something new.

The competition is grouped into three age categories: primary school, secondary school and care leavers, with a special additional award for migrant children in

care or as care leavers. Entries, which can be submitted online at www.coramvoice.org.uk/voices-2017 from 9 January until 21 February, can be in any written style including poems, short stories or newspaper articles, with a 500 word limit.

Parents and teachers in Wales encouraged to switch on to internet safety this Safer Internet Day

Young people in Wales could be at greater risk of cyber-bullying and other online risks unless we support young people to keep safe online, the Welsh Government has said.

Bullying currently affects thousands of children in Wales and instances of cyber-bullying are on the rise. The Welsh Government is attempting to tackle the issue through its anti-bullying campaign, Bullying is Everyone's Business.

To raise awareness of the importance of online safety, Welsh Government is holding an event at the Senedd on Safer Internet Day (Tuesday 7th February 2017) where Cabinet Secretary for Education, Kirsty Williams will be launching an Online Safety Zone on Hwb, the national digital learning platform for Wales.

The new Online Safety Zone is a dedicated area on Hwb designed to help keep children safe online. It will signpost those dealing with the effects of online bullying or any online safety issue towards appropriate support services.

The Dewis Cymru website contains national information pages and an all sector resource 'directory of services' which aims to provide information about how people can maintain or improve their well-being, and about organisations which can help them.

Currently, Dewis Cymru mostly holds well-being information for adults. The current section titled 'children and families' contains a relatively small amount of information for parents, families and those who work with them.

The consultation process aims to explore how Dewis Cymru might include national information pages about children and young people for use by families and professionals.

In view of the above, we would appreciate your feedback on the proposed developments of the children and young people section of Dewis Cymru. We would therefore welcome the opportunity to discuss the consultation with you. If possible,

please could we arrange for either a member of our team or a local contact to come to your team meeting to give an overview of the proposed changes and to discuss your views? We are also aiming to identify potential authors for any new National Information Pages about children and young people's well-being and we would be able to discuss this with you at the meeting.
